

Gina Rango Assistant Coach Second Season Bowling Green, 2006

Two-time Easton-Bell All-America Third-Team selection Gina Rango is in her second season with the Youngstown State softball program as an assistant coach.

Rango's responsibilities will include working with the Penguins outfielders, serving as a hitting instructor and coordinating recruiting efforts in the Mahoning Valley area.

Rango, a four-year starter at Bowling Green from 2003-06, ended her career as the Falcons' all-time leader in 10 offensive categories, including batting average (.367), home runs (26), runs batted in (132), slugging percentage (.568), hits (261) and doubles (51).

The 2005 Mid-American Conference Player of the Year, Rango was a four-time first-team All-Mid-American Conference selection and was the first Bowling Green player to earn National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-Great Lakes Region honors on more than occasion. Rango earned All-Great Lakes Region First-Team Jaurels in 2005 and 2006.

Rango, a native of North Lima, Ohio, and a 2003 graduate of Boardman High School, earned a bachelor's degree in education from Bowling Green in 2006.
